Waxing Instructions

Over time, your wax finish will require maintenance.

- 1. Use the enclosed applicator or a clean, soft cloth. Apply a small amount of wax to the wood surface. If your piece has been distressed, apply slight pressure when rubbing the wax onto the wood to ensure coverage in the recesses of the distressed areas. This will help to create a more aged look.
- 2. Wax the entire piece with a thin layer of the wax. Let it stand for 15-20 minutes until a light haze appears.
- 3. Use the Century buffing mitt to buff the haze to a shine, much like waxing an automobile.
- 4. Wash mitt in washing machine by itself. Otherwise the micro-fiber cloth will absorb lint and particles from other items.
- * You must have a Century Hand Waxing Kit before beginning any of the maintenance steps listed above. If you do not have a hand waxing kit, please contact your Century dealer.
